## 2020 April to September Covid-19 Lockdown Outreach

Even in the midst of a global pandemic, that enforced a national lockdown in 2020, it did not stop us as a ministry to be active and fruitful. I got a call from a friend that **23 families had no food for days**.

God spoke to me to follow this up and *make a difference and show the love of Jesus.* God's Word says we must feed the hungry. I immediately followed this up and got to the right person that connected me with these families who were all staying on small mini-farms in Haakdoornboom, Pretoria. We also reached out with my

team in Wolmer, Pretoria North. Our hearts were moved with tears when we saw the need amongst these families they were in desperate for help.

At every place where we gave out food I preached the Word of God and prayed for the people. At some of the places, we even lead the people in praise and worship. We helped many to renew their faith and draw closer to God. I thank God for supplying finances from different sources to help feed all these people on a regular basis. To God be all the glory. It was very rewarding to be involved in this feeding program. Seeing the gratitude in the eyes of many burned deeply into our souls.

## Other Highlights of the last year:

**11 March 2020**—We reached out to the widows who were part of +-60 seniors at the Ons Tuis Home for the Aged in Riviera, Pretoria. South Africa. I shared this scripture out of James 1:27 AMP Pure and unblemished religion in the sight of God and Father is this to visit and look after the fatherless and the widows in their distress.

Many of them are traditional Christians and some of them hardly gets a visit from their children or family. We led them into worship encouraging them to clap and lift up their hands to the Lord. An anointed word was preached giving them hope and making sure that their hearts were right with the Lord.
