Kings and Priests— The Double Anointing

Rev. 5:10 NKJV— And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth.

The Priesthood

The breakthrough is in the believer fulfilling the office of the Priesthood. The intercessor is a supportive ministry. Isaiah 61 declares that The Spirit of the Lord is upon me for service—to the brokenhearted and the sick. Plan A was that every Is-



raelite would be a priest—Ex. 19:6 NKJV And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel. But they rejected this and Plan B Aaron's priesthood came into effect.

1. Worship—The Priesthood will develop in 5 areas, and the first of those is worship. John 4:23-24 declares, *But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.* Worship is the expression of your spirit glorifying God—and that doesn't have to be singing. Dr. Hattingh begins her intercession with worship and 80% of her intercession is worship. When praying you deal with the Trinity, after worship you deal with the problem flowing in the attributes of God. God is not after worship, but the worshiper. However strong you are for God, is only as strong as your prayers.

2. Humility—The second area to develop is in humility. 2 Chron. 7:14 tells us, *If My people who are called by My name will <u>humble</u> themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land. James 4:6-7 reveals even more the blessing of humility, But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."⁷ Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.*

3. Brokenness—It is not your smartness or intelligence, but His Anointing, so a true minister of God must be immune to praise or criticism. The Anointing is servanthood and brokenness, and to be moved by God with what moves Him. True intercession is brokenness.

4. Authority—You have authority, but only to the authority of the Word in you. Luke 10:19 states, *Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you.*

And James 4:7 tells us, *Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.* Your spirit is like a satellite dish for God to move.

5. Proclaiming God's Word—Isaiah 55:11 declares the power of God's Word, So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

You are a voice in the wilderness. If God cannot break the yoke by the Anointing in you, what voice can He use?



Be a channel for God. Be a destiny prayer. Look with the eyes of God. Call what is in the heart of the Spirit. Call those things that are not as though they are (Rom. 4:17). Be a friend of God—talk about what is on His mind.

Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you—Matt 6:33. And a few verses earlier, But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly (Matt 6:6). Close the door, what you do in the secret place, God will reveal publicly. Pray the Word at your altar.
